Concurrent enrollment information and requirements

- Registration for Fall 2022 is currently open for all campuses.
- All classes are 100% Tuition free. (up to 11 units)
- Online, in person, and blended classes are available in all campuses.
- Good academic standing is necessary.
- Approval of Educational Coordinator and Academic Counselor is required.
- Students must be 16 years of age or older to participate in the work experience/internship classes.
